Greystoke, Cumberland Baptisms – Database: familysearch.org England, Births and Christenings, 1538-1975

Greystoke is a village and civil parish on the edge of the Lake District National Park in Cumbria, historically part of Cumberland. The parish is extensive, and includes the townships of Little Blencowe, Berrier with-Murrah, Gill-with-Motherby, Hutton John, Hutton Roof, Hutton Soil, Johnby, Matterdale, Mungrisdale, Threlkeld, and Water-Millock, and several hamlets. A castle was built here in the 14th century by the Greystocks, from whom the place takes its name. St Andrew's parish church, which dates from the 13th century was refounded as a collegiate church in 1382, by William, 14th Baron Greystoke.
