Wethral is a village, civil parish and electoral ward in Cumbria, formerly in Cumberland. At the historic core of the village lies the village green, in one corner of which stands Wethral Cross. The parish was divided into four townships: Great Corby and Warwick Bridge, Cumwhinton and Cotehill, Scotby, and Wethral. It is served by All Saints Church in Scotby, Holy Trinity and St Constantine in Wethral and St John the Evangelist in Cotehil.
