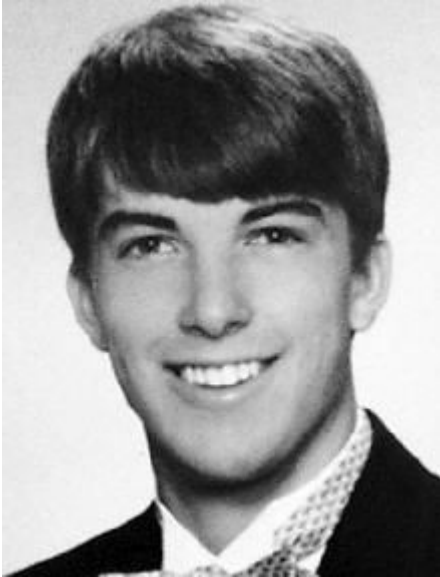


William Caleb Wharton

There will be a service of celebration of Caleb's life at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, 12291 River Rd., Richmond, at 11 a.m. Friday, November 7, 2014.
